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Privacy Statement of the Nottingham Irish Centre

The Privacy Policy of the Nottingham Irish Centre covers the way in which we maintain use or disclose personal information provided by applicants, employees, volunteers and donors.

The Nottingham Irish Centre recognises how important protecting your personal details are and therefore we want you to be assured that we exercise all necessary precautions to protect your details. Please find outlined below the ways in which we collect, store, use, disclose, and protect this information.

We collect and maintain personal information in order that we can provide services or information requested or to fulfil employment contracts with employees or agreements with volunteers and third-party organisations to further the charity's aims this to include fundraising activities.

Personal information includes any information that identifies you personally, namely your name, address, telephone number(s), and email address. National Insurance numbers, Passport ID, driving licence, bus pass, etc. may be used for security reasons for the purposes of verifying your identity.

Under the Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR), the Nottingham Irish Centre, is defined as the Data Controller and therefore as such we have a legal duty to protect any information we collect from you.

We will exercise due diligence and use the most appropriate technology and security measures to safeguard your personal details and have secure control measures to prevent unauthorised access.

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Rules of Membership of the Nottingham Irish Centre

You will provide the Nottingham Irish Centre with accurate and complete information which will include your full name, address, e-mail address, telephone number and details of an emergency contact.

You will inform the Nottingham Irish Centre of all changes to your contact information within 30 days so that we may keep our information accurate including the details of your emergency contact.

All information held by the Nottingham Irish Centre will be subject to the standard Privacy Policy which is attached to this membership form in brief and is further available from the Nottingham Irish Centre.

Subject to your compliance with these rules and the terms you agreed to when joining you will have a membership with the Nottingham Irish Centre including access to social activities and events held there along with details of the associated social media available in accordance with the terms of use which are incorporated therein.

You may cancel your membership at any time, this can be done by notifying the Nottingham Irish Centre. For the purposes of membership security this is a two-step process, firstly you should notify the Nottingham Irish Centre by email and then follow up with a telephone call verifying all of your details held. This can also be done in person by way of attendance at the Nottingham Irish Centre. In the interest of membership security, both processes must take place in order to cancel membership.

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
